Rascals

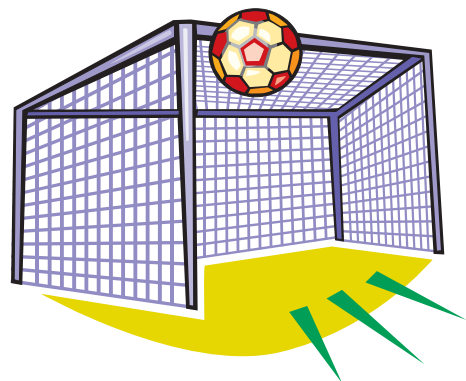

FALL FESTIVAL

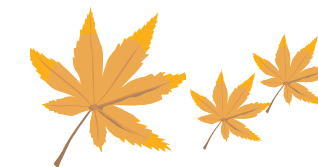
