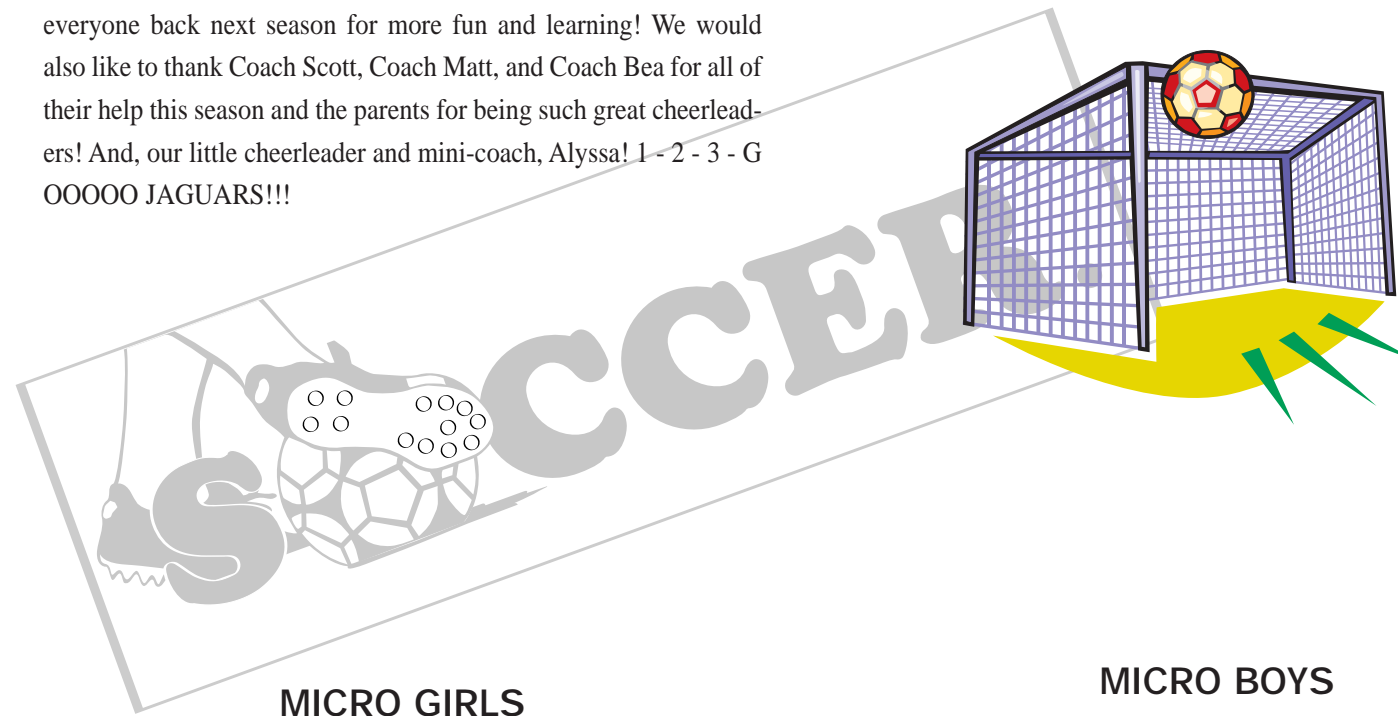
PEE WEE
