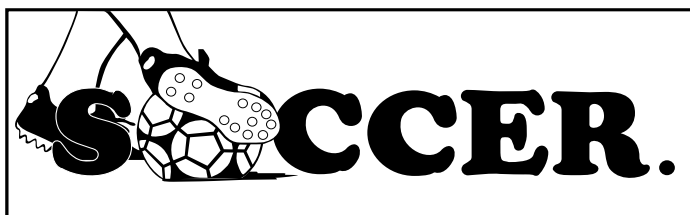
FALL FESTIVAL
