Dear Parents, Coaches, and Friends of Winslow Youth Soccer,

The Fall of 2007 marks the 30th anniversary of Winslow Township Youth Soccer Association. Many members of the WTYSA Board have devoted many hours planning the celebration of 30 years of Youth Soccer in Winslow Township. We are celebrating by giving each child a new 30th year soccer ball, and a 30th year soccer patch. New recreation uniforms representing MLS teams are being used this year. Lastly, last Saturday we had a bigger and better Super Soccer Saturday to mark our 30th anniversary with a carnival like atmosphere for the children in our township. In this planning it was our intent to have a positive article in the Courier Post representing our accomplishments to let the communities of South Jersey know the positive atmosphere created for the youth in Winslow Township from the people who care about our youth.

I would like to share with you some of these accomplishments:

- Child participation has increased by 22% over last year. There are 778 children playing recreation and travel soccer in Winslow.
- While many soccer organizations do not offer a Recreation soccer programs, Winslow has this program for the child who enjoys the game, but does not desire to play at the competitive level of the Travel Program. Winslow also maintains this program to have a training program for players who desire to transition to Travel Soccer.
- Our tots program was started 6 years ago with 40 participants and has grown to 92 today.
- In 2008, three new fields will open at the Volpe Complex.
- Vince D'Antonio has built a fantastic website.
- Our fields are greener and the grass is fuller thanks to the devotion of Mike Skurnik.
- In 2007 additional practice lights will be installed at Volpe. Thank you Paul Lipari for leading this program.
- There are 14 travels teams playing in the SJ League - 8 boys teams in SJSJL and 6 girls teams in SJGSL



Team Highlights:

- Winslow Tigers, coached by Rich King, are the #1 team in SJ U10 Girls
- Winslow Wizards, coached by Al Giebner and Kevin DeBlasi, are the #2 team in SJ U14 Girls
- Winslow Web, coached by Jay McKeowen, is one of the top 3 teams in SJ U11 Boys.
- Winslow Magic, coached by Bob Santos, is the #4 team in SJ U16 Boys.
- The U14 Boys Winslow Force (Coach Craig McGee) had 2 players playing in SJ Select Soccer league in the Spring of 2007.
- Francine Hallman and Robin Schneeman each were awarded the Sportsmanship Award for their U10 Girls Division in the Fall of 2006 in SJGSL. Robin was awarded this award again in the Spring 2007.

The Courier Post did not write about the positive of our community; instead the Staff Writer, Bill Duhrt, decided that his article was a key representation of the turmoil in our community.
