Hurricanes

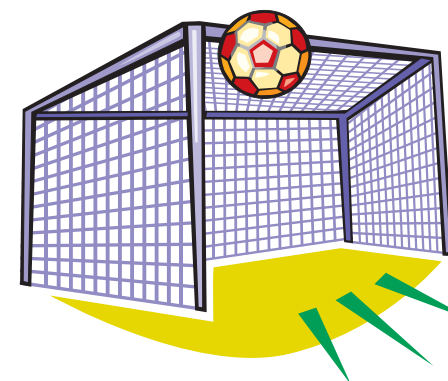
