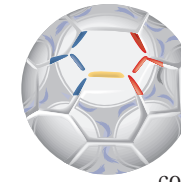

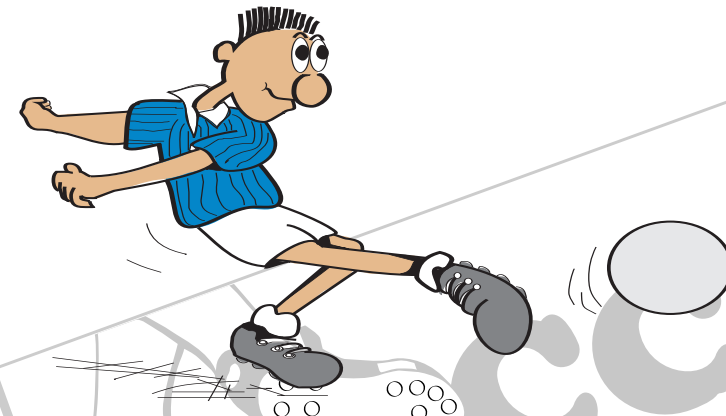
The Little Giants
