We have been able to combine the registration & payment process with the clinic sign-up this year. Please go to www.ussoccer.info and follow the steps to register. As you complete the registration process on this site, please choose the clinic you wish to attend. Please use the help functions found on the site should you run into difficulty

Instructions for BRAND NEW REFEREES (first-time):

- When registering you are registering for a full (2) day clinic, do not sign up for a recertification clinic.
- (2) day clinic dates and times are noted below.
- Payment is done online, the amount will be \$55.
- Clinics are full days, plan to bring snacks and a lunch.
- Remember to bring a pen or pencil to the clinic for the test.

The Municipal Building in South Burlington (police station) is located on Dorset Street.

If you are a new referee and your state accepts new online users, you will need to take 2 steps to apply for your registration:

STEP 1 - CREATE A USER ID

1. At the www.ussoccer.info home page, click on NEW USER signup
2. Create a User ID that you will remember (write it down) and a password (write it down). They are NOT case sensitive.
3. Fill in the rest of the form (**ONLY** the fields with a red asterisk).
4. At the bottom of the form, click SAVE
5. You will get a message "User Registration Confirmation". At the bottom right corner of the confirmation box you will see the word "Login", click on the word "Login".

STEP 2 - COMPLETE THE ONLINE FORM and PAYMENT

1. Enter the User ID and password you created in Step 1
2. You will see a "Welcome Screen"
3. Click on the blue underlined text "Click here to Register for 2010"
4. Click on the "Referee" box in the "Register As" section. The screen will fill in any appropriate details. Be sure to choose the correct Referee Grade using the pull down menu (NOTE: THIS IS NOT YOUR SCHOOL GRADE). In most cases it will be Referee Grade 8.
5. Some States require you sign up for a clinic. If so, make the appropriate choice.
6. Complete the rest of the form.
7. At the bottom of the form you can make a payment for your application.
8. Once your credit card is approved, you will get a confirmation page with your application/clinic details PRINT for your records. If you have entered a valid email address you will also get this confirmation page emailed to you.
9. Be sure to check your state website for any other requirements for completing your application. Contact information for your state is provided at the bottom of the confirmation page.
