Second Season Information

As in past years, we are offering to help a team that wishes to play more soccer after the Fall 2009 Recreational season is over. We refer to this as “second season” or Maricopa League and the highlights are as follows:

1. The league you will be playing in is called AYSA Maricopa League and is called Maricopa League or Open League.
2. The cost is \$350 for 9 year old teams and younger and \$400 for 11 year old teams and older. This works out to slightly less than \$30 per player.
3. The season is 6 Saturday games and runs from December 12, 2009, through March 6, 2010. There are no games on December 26, 2009, nor January 2, 2010.
4. You can select 3 “no play dates” which means you will not be scheduled for games on those 3 dates. If you know your team will be unavailable for a play date, select that as a No Play Date and you will not be scheduled for a game.
5. Home games will be played at Scottsdale fields such as Mtn View Park or Chaparral Park. Away games are nearly always in the Greater Phoenix area.
6. Commitment date: November 8, 2009. We need to know that you are playing no later than this date. Here is the complete list of information needed:

Team name

Contact name (coach or manager)

Age of oldest player as of July 31, **2009**

(This determines what “division” you are assigned to.)

Contact phone

Three “no play” date requests

(If none are chosen, Dec 12, Feb 27, and Mar 6 will be used.)

7. By November 13, 2009, we need to have your team payment and your “no play” dates as the dates will be entered into the scheduling system at this time.

1. Maricopa League is geared toward players 8 years old and older. There are fewer teams at the 6-7 year old ages and the teams seem to be more competitive at these ages. If you are a 6-7 year old team, you will have the most fun if you have been a very successful Recreational team.
2. Cost: teams 9 and younger: \$350; teams 11 and older: \$400. This amount covers all players on the team.
3. Payment made to: ASUSC / Scottsdale Soccer
4. Mail payment to: Scottsdale Soccer, PO Box 5075, Scottsdale, AZ 85261
5. GotSoccer.com is the online administration system used for Maricopa League. If your current team has an “account” with GotSoccer.com, please let us know you will be using that account. Otherwise, we will establish an account for you, enter the information needed to be associated with Scottsdale Soccer and our fields, and then give you the account name and password. If you don’t understand any of this, your team likely doesn’t have an account and we will get one set up for you.
6. Second Season is primarily for players already playing in the Scottsdale Soccer recreation league. You can have players from different Rec teams play on your Maricopa League team. For the occasional new player, the registration fee will be \$50; the new player will also need to pay to the coach a share of the team fee. A completed registration form is needed for the new player as well.
7. Your team is expected to use your current recreational league uniforms. If you have difficulties with uniforms, please send Email to uniforms@asusc.com
8. All Rec coaches should already have a Disclosure form on file with Scottsdale Soccer. The coach may need to sign a Coach’s Code of Conduct.
9. Each player (and coach) will need to provide a 1”x1” picture (face shot) for use with the player ID card. The ID card serves as roster authentication during game check in with referees.
10. Your team will be put in the lowest “division” (highest number) for your team age group which is where recreational teams play.
